Circle Punch
Scissors
Brads
Paper flowers

Paper Daisies

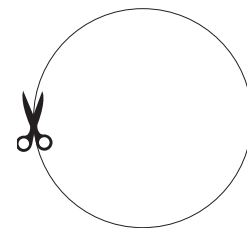
These are the cutest little embellishments to jazz up any project. Paper daisies can be made in any size, and are a great addition to any scrapbook layout, or Beyond-the-page project. With a simple pattern, you'll use these over and over again!



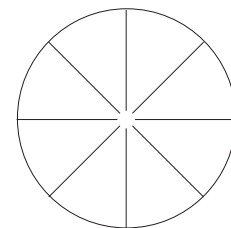
KAISERCRAFT

1: Cut your circles- (2 circles makes one daisy)

Your circles can be any size you like, depending on the Daisy size you would like.



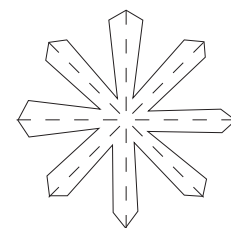
2: Once you have cut your circles, make 8 cuts as shown. Do not cut all the way through the circle, you will need to leave a small circle area in the middle where you will place the Brad.



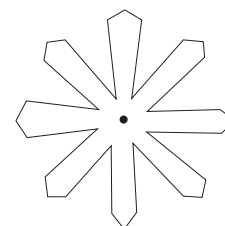
Repeat step 2 as many times as you like for your daisy layers.

3: Fold the petals-

Fold each petal in half length ways as shown with the dotted line.



4: Make holes in the middle of the daisies. It is best to use a craft knife tip so the hole is small.



5: Make Daisy-

Place 2 Daisies over the top of each other and secure together with Brad. You can alter the daisies facing upward and down for another technique or place a Paper daisy underneath brad for extra effect.
