Scrapbooking paper  
Cutout Elements (we have used  
the birds from the Pina Colada paper collection)  
Kindy Glitz/ Glitter to embellish.



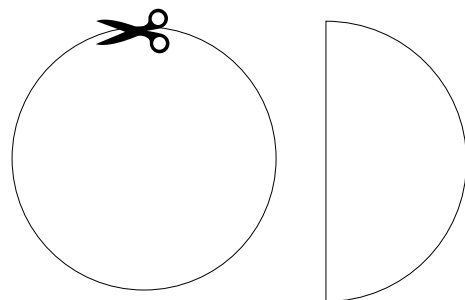
# Cocktail Straws



This easy little decoration is so quick and will add so much interest and personality to your drinks at your next cocktail party. Made from one simple yet versatile pattern, you will find endless possibilities for this paper craft.

1: Punch out your circles-

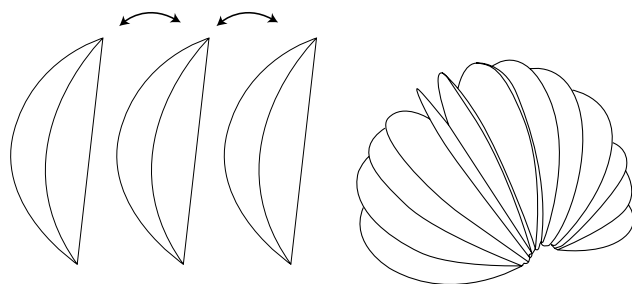
Your circles can be any size, depending on the paper decoration size you would like. The number of circles cut out also depends on how thick you would like the decoration. Approx 11 will make a good sized ball.



2: Fold all the circles in half. Make sure the pattern that you would like your decoration to be in folded inward.

3: Starting with one circle, glue one half to another half of another circle.

Repeat.



4: Once you have made a half dome, glue your cut out element to one side. Shown here in figure a. Place your half dome (with your cut out element) around your straw, then glue the two ends together.
