# Notebooks

Ever thought of using your scrapbooking left overs and scraps to cover school books, notepads and stationary? No more excuses for boring covered books, this is a easy and creative way of adding interest and colour to your lifeless stationary without paying a fortune.



- 1: Take the covers off your books by stretching apart the spiral bind. Cover your book, as if you were wrapping a present. If you have a Crop a Dile it will be very easy for you to punch out your holes. If not, simply trace the binder holes onto your paper and hole punch the holes out.
  - 2: Add strips of contrasting paper and ribbon.
  - 3: Cut out elements from your paper range and foam dot for dimension.
  - 4: Add alpha chipboard, buttons, brads and ribbon to embellish. Put the covers back on the books
- Cover other stationary objects such as book binders, pencil holders, pencils, rulers... Anything you like!
