



Stitched Christmas Stocking

Hand made gifts are ones that really stand out, so whip up this nifty little stocking and fill it with treats for that special child in your life - they'll just love it!

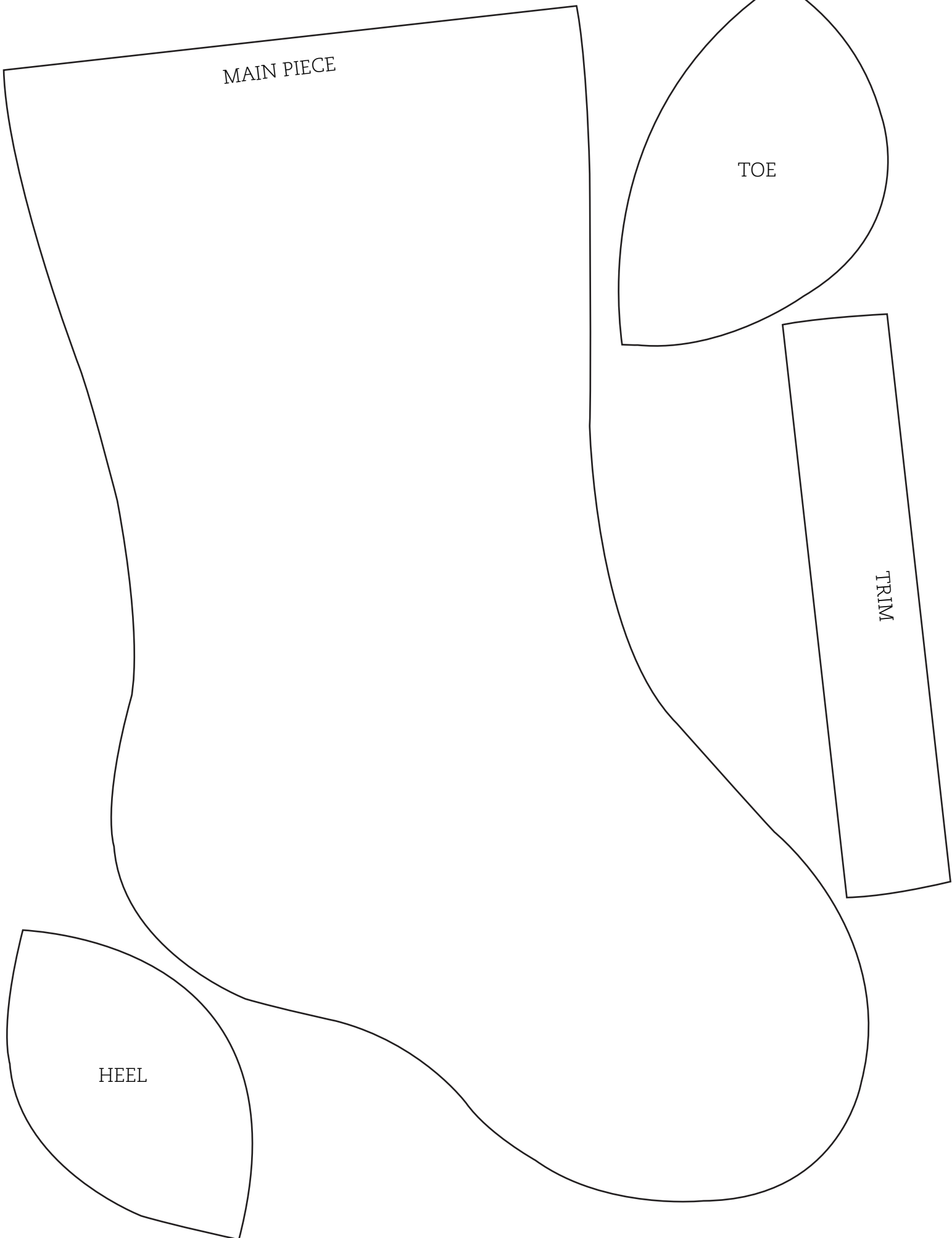
KC MATERIALS: Christmas Carnival papers (2 papers of your choice), Christmas Carnival Diecut Elements (Optional), Christmas Carnival Brads (Optional), Christmas Carnival Black & White Rubons (Optional) **OTHER:** Scissors, needle, thread, glue, ribbon

Easy

- 1** Choose two papers from Christmas Carnival and use the template on the following page to cut out each piece for your stocking. If you are only scrapping the front of the stocking you will need two cut outs of the main piece and one of each of the other pieces; if you are scrapping the front and back of your stocking, you will need two pieces of the main piece and two cut outs of each other sock pieces.
- 2** Glue each of the sock pieces to the main stocking piece, and begin stitching your stocking together. We have used a combination of straight edge stitching on the outside of the stocking and criss cross stitching on the inside 'sock' pieces. Try experimenting with different stitching techniques to find the combination that you're most happy with.
- 3** If you would like your stocking to be able to hang, then loop a piece of ribbon and sew it together. Tuck the sewn loop into the inside of the stocking and sew it on at the back of the stocking. Embellish and/or scrap the stocking as desired using diecut elements, brads and rubons. All you need to do now is fill it with treats for your child and watch their excitement as they dig out their goodies on Christmas day!

Tip

Embellish your child's name on the front of the stocking using chipboard letters, alpha stickers and glitter - they'll get such a kick getting their own personalised Christmas stocking!
